## 2022 OKLAHOMA MASONIC FUNDRAISER **OFFICIAL RULES**

Must be at least 18 years of age.

Grand Lodge Trustees are ineligible to win the Prizes.

The raffle tickets will sell for \$20.00 each, of which a percentage (based on number of tickets sold) will be returned to the Lodge that has sold the ticket(s).

The breakdown of money incentive d returned to the lodge will adhere to the following rules:

1-100 Tickets sold = \$5.00 per Ticket 201-300 Tickets sold= \$6.00 per Ticket 101-200 Tickets sold= \$5.50 per Ticket

301-349 Tickets sold= \$6.50 per Ticket

350- or more Tickets sold= \$7.00 per Ticket

Checks sent to the Grand Lodge for tickets sold should be made payable to the Oklahoma Masonic Fundraiser.

PRIZES: There will be two (2) drawings for a Grand Prize of \$25,000 cash each. Next, there will be ten (10) separate drawings for cash winnings of \$1,000 each. Following those drawings there will be five (5) separate drawings for cash winnings of \$500. All winners will be randomly hand drawn by special attendees at the Friday afternoon, November 11, 2022 open (public) session of Grand Lodge of 2022 Annual Communication. The winners of any of the aforementioned prizes need NOT be present to win. Any tickets drawn will not be returned to the raffle tumbler or considered for any further drawings.

The Grand Lodge is not responsible for any of the local, state, or federal taxes associated with the winning of any prizes. The winner of any prize will be responsible for the aforementioned taxes. The Grand Lodge will adhere to all local, state, and federal laws pertaining to reporting documents and collection of money (TAXES) associated with the sale of the tickets for this fundraiser.

All reasonable attempts will be made to contact any winner utilizing the phone number provided on the ticket stub. If any prize is not claimed within 30 calendar days, the total value of the prize will be returned to the Grand Lodge general fund.

TOP SELLERS - The Constituent Lodges of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of Oklahoma are separated into three (3) categories based on membership. Category one (1) = 1-75 members, category two (2) = 76-200 members, and category three (3) = 201 and above members. The categories will be identified at the beginning of the fundraiser year and cannot be adjusted during the 2022 Fundraiser. The Lodges that sell the highest total number of tickets in each of category will be eligible for prizes. The top lodge seller in each category will receive a \$5,000.00 gift card. The Lodge that sell the second highest total number of tickets in each category will be eligible for a \$1,250.00 gift card, and Lodges that sell the third highest total number of tickets in each of the categories will be eligible for a \$1,000.00 gift card. These lodges will be announced Saturday afternoon during the closed session of Grand Lodge. The Lodges identified are eligible for these awards and must have at least one of their elected dais officers (Worshipful Master, Senior Warden, or Junior Warden) present during the announcement to receive the award. If at least one of these officers are not present at the Grand Lodge during the Annual Communication on Saturday November 12, 2022, the lodge that has sold the next highest total number of tickets in each category, will be eligible to receive the prize under the same conditions of being present at the Annual Communication.

The Lodges will make arrangements to have the tickets stubs and money delivered or mailed to the Grand Lodge. The ticket stubs and money must be in balance and is the responsibility of the Worshipful Master of the lodge (example, 100 tickets to turn in must have \$2000.00 with it). The Fundraiser Committee will be responsible for accounting verification and balance of ticket stubs and money, as well as keeping the necessary records of ticket accountability and all other needed figures for the operation of the fundraiser. The money and stubs will then be given to the Grand Treasurer for his receipt and deposit.

All prizes are presented when all legally required paperwork has been satisfied according to the State and Federal laws. The Lodge awards will be calculated and mailed after all funds are received and deposited by the Grand Treasurer. Tickets will remain available for sale until the 11 November 2022 Open Session of Grand Lodge has been called to order, however credit for the lodge awards will be cutoff at 3:00pm on 1 November 2022. Any tickets mailed to the Grand Lodge must be nost marked no later than 1 November 2022
