2020 Advanced Blue

Grand Lodge of Oklahoma

- 1. The guidelines for this year, a lodge who signs up to participate must be able to perform the Entered Apprentice degree in its entirety, including the explanatory lectures, with only the members of that lodge. (No outside help from other lodges.)
- 2. Basic Blue is still available but is not required in order to participate in the Advanced Blue.
- 3. It does not require that each officer has to do the work in the chair to which he has been elected or appointed.
- 4. All Advanced Blue certifications must be received by the Grand Secretary's office no later than October 16, 2020.
- 5. There are no individual certificates; only the lodge will receive recognition for their participation and will be recognized at the 2020 Grand Lodge Session.
- 6. A. A Lodge must open on the Entered Apprentice degree.
 - B. Confer the first and second sections in their entirety.
 - C. Present the second and third section explanatory lectures.
 - D. Close on the Entered Apprentice Degree.
