We encourage all lodges to contact the high schools in your areas and ask them to participate in the **2020-2021 Senior Essay Contest. All Oklahoma Public School Seniors are eligible to participate in this contest.**

Along with this letter, you are receiving **two** packets of information for the teachers. If more copies are needed, please notify us, and we will send a packet directly to the school. The information will also be available on the Foundation website. All of the rules and instructions for the process are included in the teacher kit. Please be advised that only online essays will be accepted.

We ask that a Lodge member deliver the school letter and contest flyer to the Senior English teacher by the first week of school. Please point out to them the change to online submissions, and that the contest deadline is October 31, 2020.

Statewide and local winners in both Men's and Women's Divisions will be notified in February. Certificates will be mailed to your Lodge, or the school if your Lodge has so chosen, in April.

Statewide winners checks will be mailed directly to your Lodge in April for presentation to the students. Please notify us if your Lodge plans a certificate presentation earlier than April.

Local winners certificates will be mailed to your Lodge, or the school if your Lodge has so chosen. in April. Please notify us if your Lodge plans a certificate presentation earlier than April.
